

Word for the Month: LOVE

Thought for the Month:

When we picture love, we often think softness. In fact, thanks to the Hallmark and Hershey franchises, the very mention of the word love makes us immediately think of Valentine's Day. But what if we have it all wrong? What if love is muscular? What if love is heavy, loud, and massive? What if love is aggressive? So aggressive that God sent love into this world that whoever believes in love will not perish but love will make certain that they live forever. What if love is strong? Like – STRONG! What if love is so strong, it kept Jesus on the cross to die for each of us, even though He could have released himself?

It is important that we get a new view of love. Love is not the opposite of hate. Opposites denote equity: love is the not the equal of hate. Drivers will scan the front of the ticket (invoice) and then scan the back (the payment). Push the call button if you have any issues and the LAZ Garage Staff will assist you.

Saturday & Sunday

Parking is available on Saturday and Sunday until 4 pm (unless otherwise noted). Park on levels P2 or P3 and take the elevator to the "G" level to exit the building (to the left toward 11th Street). The church provides parking passes (half sheet paper passes) to use as you exit the garage. You must give the parking attendant your printed ticket and the parking pass.





Beginning the week of September 7, all bulletin-related emails should be sent to our new group email: bulletin@asburyumcdc.org


This centralized system will make it easier to track contributions and prepare each week's bulletin with clarity and care. If you have an announcement or request for inclusion, please use this email only moving forward.
